Design



Just like many other tulip lovers from Western Europe, the designers of Tulpi-Design have taken their lead from this round, cup-shaped flower. It's flow and symmetry forms the basis for the Tulpi-Bin.

While the tulip feeds on water, sunlight and minerals, the Tulpi-Bin feasts on litter.
